Featured Commuter of the Month

Madonna is an experienced clean commuter who understands what it takes to create a successful ride-sharing experience. This month’s featured commuter of the month commutes every day from her home in Lennon, Michigan, to downtown Lansing.

Madonna commutes in one of our MichiVan vanpools with 10 other people. She is the main contact for the van, providing reports to the other poolers, discussing just how the vanpool operates with interested commuters, and providing information to MichiVan and Clean Commute Options, etc.

With a one hour commute, each way, Madonna is happy to be sharing the ride, as it helps to make the time go by. She has been clean commuting for almost three years, and the vanpool situation has proven to be one that works out well for her. Not only is she saving money on the wear and tear on her own personal vehicle, but she is able to receive the Emergency Ride Home benefit as well. So what is Madonna’s advice for a successful pooling experience?

“Never forget that this is just a ride to work and back home, with people you hopefully enjoy being with. Don’t take bumps in the road too seriously, and don’t expect to be bosom buddies with everyone on the van. It’s like a new pair of shoes – some fit really great and you could wear them all day while others, you wish you had never bought. Not that we’ve ever had those kinds of shoes on OUR van!” laughs Madonna.

2010 vanpool and seat pricing

MichiVan operates the commuter vanpool program under contract to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT). The vanpool program continues to enjoy success as a result of the popularity of the passenger seat pricing program. On an annual basis MDOT reviews the pricing structure and subsidy levels in order to maintain the programs viability for commuters statewide.

Effective October 1, 2009, new seat prices shown below will take effect. Because MichiVan charges fares in advance, the new rates will be reflected on amounts due September 15, 2009, for checking customers and September 20, 2009, for credit card customers.

Pricing involves many factors which are tied to federal and state subsidy dollars. Fares are used to offset Federal and State subsidy dollars, which in turn allows the program to grow and serve more commuters. MDOT remains committed to rates that encourage ridesharing while also promoting the use of larger passenger vehicles requiring less subsidy dollars and removing more vehicles from Michigan roads.

Our expectation is that the new seat pricing schedule will remain in effect until the end of the fiscal year on 9/30/2010. However it is important to note, prices remain the purview of MDOT and may be changed at any time subject to 30 day notification period.

Listed below are the new monthly seat prices effective for the month of October 2009. Prices are shown without applicable sales tax. Gas and Parking are also not included. Price difference from 2009 prices is noted parenthetically in Table 1 and Table 2. The price difference between Table 2 and Table 3 is noted parenthetically in Table 3.
